PUBLIC HEALTH ACT  
(CAP. 111)

PUBLIC HEALTH (NATIONAL BUILDING CODE)  
REGULATIONS 2004

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 39 and with the approval of the Minister, the Board makes these Regulations—

*Citation*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Health (National Building Code) Regulations 2004.

*Application*

2. These Regulations apply to the whole of the Fiji Islands.

*National Building Code*

3.—(1) The National Building Code set out in the Schedule shall be used for construction of all buildings to which the Act applies, for all classes of occupancy.

(2) If a regulation or by-law made under the Act or under any other written law before or after the commencement of these regulations is inconsistent with any requirement under the National Building Code, the requirement in the Code prevails.

*Breach of Code*

4. A person who fails to comply with a requirement of the Code commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$200 and if the non-compliance continues, to a further fine not exceeding \$4 a day for each day during which the non-compliance continues after the conviction.
